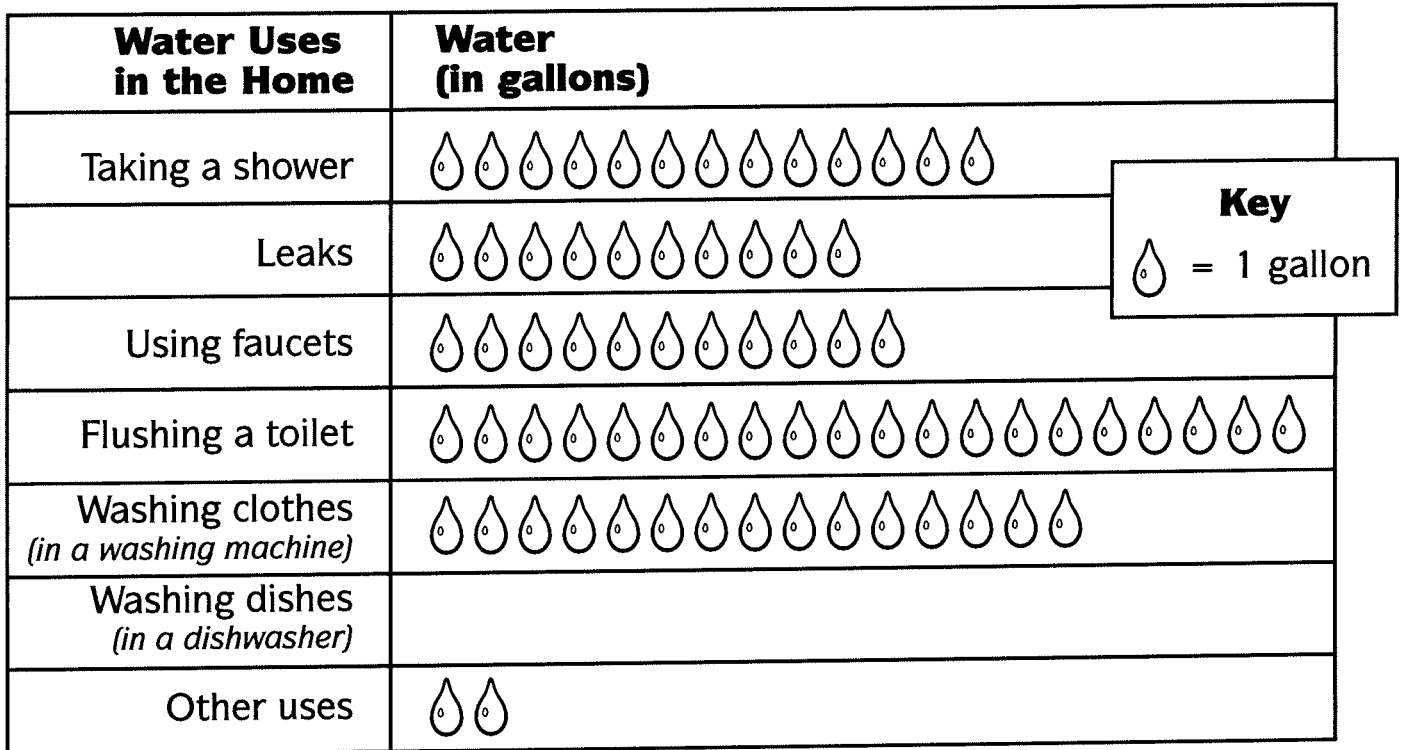


WATCH YOUR WATER USE!
